Dear Baby Bird Feeder Volunteer:

This letter is in response to your interest in the baby bird feeder program at the Wildlife In Need Center. We have 3 training classes scheduled. All volunteers, including past experienced baby bird feeders, must attend 1 of the 3 classes. Adults who will volunteer with 12 and 13 year olds should also attend. Parents and guardians of 14 years and older volunteers are welcome as well but not required to attend.

Training Class: **Wednesday, May 18 6:30-8:30 pm**
 Sunday, May 22 1:30-3:30pm
 Saturday, May 28 1:30-3:30pm

Where: Training Classes are held at Brandybrook Community Center. Brandybrook Community Center is located on Hwy 18, 1.8 miles east of Hwy 83 in Wales, on the north side of the road, at the Brandybrook Road intersection.

Fee: \$10 for non-members, free to WINC members (includes all family members). A basic annual membership is \$35 but we give a discount to our volunteers. Your fee helps pay for class and education materials.

This is important so that we can plan adequate space for the class and class materials, as well as advise you of any last minute changes. Bring your completed Baby Bird Feeding Application and also your completed Emergency Contact and Availability Form to the class. These are 2-sided forms so please fill out both sides.

Feel free to call if you have any questions. Please note that children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult, both for the class and for volunteer shifts at the Center.
