



Dear Baby Bird Feeder Volunteer:

This letter is in response to your interest in the Baby Bird Feeder program at the Wildlife In Need Center. If you would like to volunteer in 2019, please fill out an **Adult and Minor Baby Bird Feeding Application/Release Form** (which includes an Emergency Contact and Shift Availability Form), even if you have filled one out in previous years. We do ask for updated info each year.

We have 3 orientation classes scheduled. All volunteers, including past experienced baby bird feeders, must attend 1 of the 3 classes. Adults who will volunteer with 12- and 13-year olds should also attend. Parents and guardians of children ages 14 years and older are welcome as well but not required to attend.

Bring your completed Baby Bird Feeding Application (including the Emergency Contact and Shift Availability Forms) to the class. These are 2-sided forms so please fill out both sides.

Feel free to call if you have any questions. Please note that children 12 and 13 years old must be accompanied by an adult, both for the orientation class and for volunteer shifts at the Center.
