You will have the ability to create your own schedule around WINC's hours and as agreed upon in advance. After successful completion of the summer, a stipend will be provided.

Responsibilities

- Responsible in all aspects of photographic and video communications
- Responsible for the end-to-end process from storyboarding to logistics, shooting, editing, and publishing
- Shoot photographs and film video at the Wildlife In Need Center and field environments
- Contribute to mixing and editing to create polished and engaging videos
- Touch-up still photography and publish videos primarily to the web and WINC's social media
- Completion of one short video (less than 2 mins) a week and shorter videos if time permits
- With permission, advice and collaboration with WINC's Animal Care Manger and Education Coordinator, decide what rehabilitating patients and educational animal ambassadors to highlight
- Overall goal is to expand WINC's presence on social media to spread awareness of WINC's mission

Requirements

- Have the potential to deliver photos and videos that concisely and clearly tell the desired story independently
- Ability to deliver videos with cuts, graphics, sound and other elements that convey a quality production value and a level of technical sophistication
- Knowledge of digital photography and videography cameras
- Must be 19 years or older
- Must have own computer, camera(s); having a GoPro is a plus
- Video editing and motion graphics using Adobe Premier Pro or similar professional programs

- Experience in Adobe Illustrator and Adobe Photoshop are a bonus
- Must be proactive, organized, able to create content independently and demonstrate strong communication skills
- Professional resume required
