Thank you for your interest in the Baby Bird Feeder (BBF) program at the Wildlife in Need Center. If you would like to volunteer:

- **People 12-14 years old** - May become baby bird feeders. They must be accompanied by an adult, both for the orientation and for volunteer shifts at the Center. Please email volunteer@helpingwildlife.org to set up a brief pre-training phone or Zoom™ interview. Communication for scheduling of the interview will be through email. After successful completion of the interview, you will be scheduled for an orientation.
- **People 15+ years** – Are welcome to become Baby Bird Feeders. Please RSVP (with your name and phone number) by calling (262)965-3090 to sign up for an orientation.

- All volunteers, including past experienced BBF's, must attend 1 of the classes.
- Volunteers ages 12-14 must be accompanied by the adult they will be volunteering with after successfully completing their interview beforehand.
- Also on our website is the **Adult and Minor Baby Bird Feeding Application/Release Form** (which includes an Emergency Contact and Shift Availability Form). ****Please bring these completed forms to your orientation class**, even if you have filled one out in previous years. We do ask for updated information each year.
